Alfred Harris, was a Son & Seventh Child of John and Mary Jane Harris. Alfred was born in Woodville New Zealand on the 8th of June 1888 & Died at Awapuni Hospital Palmerston North on the 10th of June 1968.

Elsie Ada born in Woodville NZ in 1893, was the Daughter of John T & Emily Clark and she died in a car accident in 1939.

Alfred Married Elsie Ada Clark at Woodville in 1913 & had three children, Henry Alfred,born 1914, Ronald born 1917, & Mavis Elizabeth born 1919.

Alfred grew up & went to School in Woodville.

Alfred and family moved to Havelock north (unknown when, maybe around 1925?) where the children went to school. (Described, while driving around Havelock, first hand by Ronald Harris) Alfred's Father John also lived in the area Napier/Havelock North.

It is estimated they moved back to Woodville around 1935, Alfred & Elsie were on a Dairy Farm situated at the corner of Ormond Road & Troup Road in Woodville.

Elsie was killed in a car Accident in 1939 at age 46, after which Alfred moved to Hamilton, Rotorua & Finally Napier where he lived with his sister Maud Dobbie in Campaign Street & worked on the Railway, leaving his grown up family in Woodville where they all got married and continued to live in Woodville.

Alf moved from Napier to Palmerston North around 1956 where his son Ronald & Daughter Mavis, lived with their Families at that time.

Alfred first lived down Broadway Ave in a one room Hutt, then moved to Brightwater Home & finally to Awapuni Hospital where he Died, leaving behind his two Sons & Daughter plus Twelve Grandchildren.

Elsie (After her accident) was buried at the Old Gorge Cemetery in Woodville in 1939. Alfred was cremated at Kelvin Grove Cemetery and later his ashes were placed on his wife Elsie's Grave in the "Old Gorge Cemetery" at Woodville NZ.

A tragic accident occurred on the Ormond Road near Woodville at 9.45 last evening, resulting in the death of Mrs. Elsie Ada Harris, aged 46, wife of Mr. Alfred Harris, farmer, Woodville. Mrs. Harris had been visiting friends with her husband. They were on their way home when the accident occurred. Mr. Harris was' driving and noticed that the front door on his wife's side of the car was loose on its catch. Mrs. Harris leaned forward to pull it closed, but instead pushed it open and fell to the roadway, landing on her head. Death was instantaneous.
